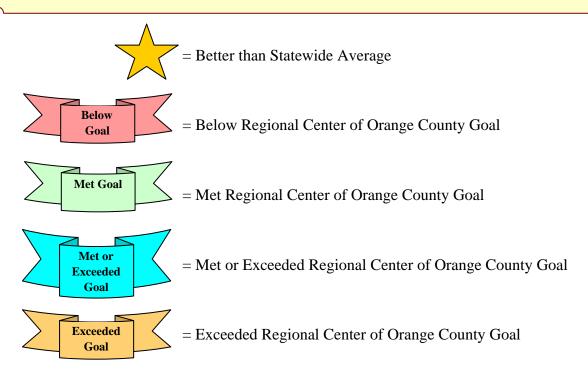


Performance Contract 2007 Cover Sheet

Objective: RCOC will continue to seek new and innovative methods of utilizing available resources, developing non-existing resources, and creating and implementing transition plans that will allow individuals to establish themselves and participate successfully in their home community living arrangements.

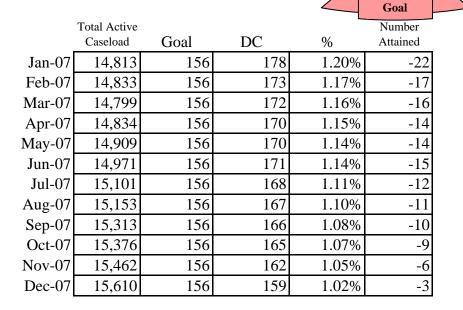
• Implementation of Community Placement Plan for FYs 2006-2007 and 2007-2008.

II. Children Residing with Families (Child is defined as under 18 years of age).

Planned Activities

Statement: The Regional Center of Orange County ensures that children will reside with their families by providing the needed supports and services regardless of the severity of the child's disability.

Objectives: Service Coordinators continue to identify, publicize and facilitate access to supports and services for children with developmental disabilities who are considered at risk for out-of-home placement.

- RCOC wil continue to assess current supports and services.
- RCOC will provide information on IFSP/IPP and process through development of a DVD which will be available for all families.
- RCOC will continue to develop innovative resources for children 0-3 years old (i.e., respite placement).
- RCOC will ensure that consumers are provided opportunities for safety awareness training through schools and Get Safe Programs.
- RCOC will work with the Orange County community in an effort to support programs, training and services that are designed to provide equal access to child care for children with special needs.
- RCOC will assure that families receive full information about the developmental needs of the consumer and services available in a user-friendly format. Information will be given individually or through agency newsletter "Dialogue".
- RCOC will assure that consumers and their caregivers receive complete assessments and have opportunity to ask questions, advocate, and access services. To be evaluated and monitored by a NCI survey of consumers and their caregivers.
- RCOC will provide educational advocacy through special training for service coordinators and contracts with Pepperdine and Whittier Law Schools.
- RCOC will provide parent advocacy in accessing community social/recreational activities.
- RCOC will explore addition of a section entiltled "Frequently asked questions" to RCOC website.

III. Adults Residing in Home Settings

Planned Activities

Statement: RCOC works with consumers and their caregivers and advocates to empower and enable them to assert the consumer's rights to determine and control the living arrangements of their choice. This may include owning, renting, or leasing the home where the consumer resides.

Objective: Using the Person Centered Individual Program Planning process, Service Coordinators will continue to identify regional center adult consumers who have the hopes and desires to live in a new living arrangement. Cases are reviewed at least annually for the least restrictive environment.

- RCOC will provide information on IPP and process through development of a DVD which will be available for all families.
- RCOC will require vendors to include successionary maintenance and transitional plans in the event of temporary illness/incapacity and transfer of ownership in their Program Design.
- RCOC will ensure that consumers are provided opportunities for safety awareness training through Get Safe Programs.
- RCOC will assure that families receive full information about the developmental needs of the
 consumer and services available throughout the community in a user-friendly format and explore use of
 RCOC website.
- RCOC will provide information on home ownership and rental assistance through Housing Urban Development (HUD/Section 8), accessibility and landlord/tenant questions.
- RCOC will provide additional training to service coordinators on issues facing consumers and their caregivers. IPP/PCPs will incorporate an objective for futures planning.
- RCOC provides individualized independent living skills training to consumers through vendors and conferences within RCOC POS guidelines.
- RCOC will assure that consumers and their caregivers receive complete assessments and have opportunity to ask questions, advocate, and access services. To be evaluated and monitored by a NCI survey of consumers and their caregivers.
- RCOC will explore addition of a section entiltled "Frequently asked questions" to RCOC website.

- RCOC will strive to improve the services and supports available to those in these larger facilities to ensure the best possible developmental experience.

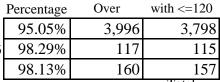
